Depending on the course you have applied for and whether you achieved a Band 5, 6 or E4 in high-level English or mathematics in the NSW HSC (or equivalent scores in other Australian Year 12 qualifications and the IB) in 2024, you can have an adjustment of up to five points added to your ATAR or equivalent IB score, to raise your selection rank for an eligible course.

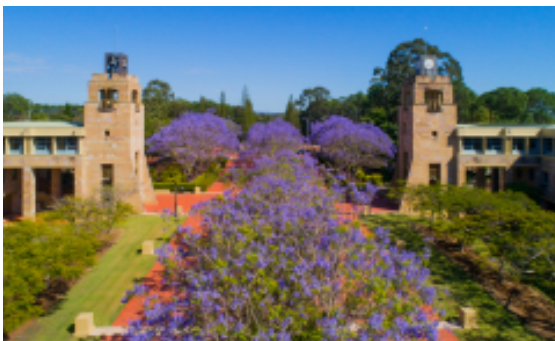

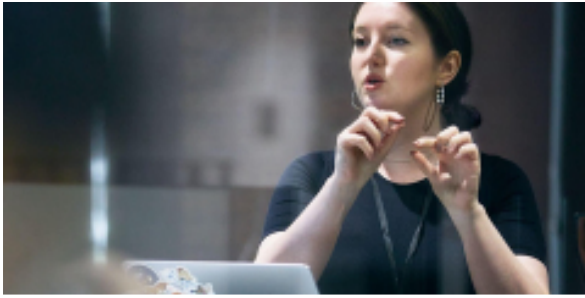

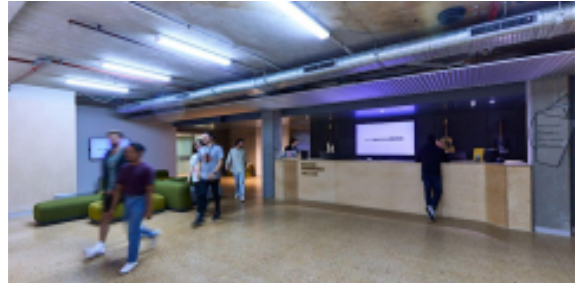
